

Cancellation Rights for Consumers

If you are a consumer as defined by the Cancellation of Consumer Contracts (Information, Cancellation and Additional Charges) Regulations 2013, you have the right to cancel this contract within 14 days without giving any reason.

The cancellation period will expire after 14 days from the day you instruct me. To exercise the right to cancel, you must inform me of your decision to cancel this contract by a written communication to me. You may use the attached form below, but it is not obligatory.

To meet the cancellation deadline, it is sufficient for you to send your communication concerning your exercise of the right to cancel before the cancellation period has expired.

If you cancel this contract, I will reimburse to you without delay all payments received from you. If you requested to begin the performance of services during the cancellation period, you shall pay me an amount which is in proportion to what has been performed until you have communicated your cancellation from this contract, in comparison with the full coverage of the contract.
